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

\$1,597.90 to plaintiff Cindy Camara for damages

Summary of Facts:

Cindy Camara was a customer at Winco Foods LLC when an employee of Winco pushed a row of shopping carts into Camara.

Cindy Camara and her husband, Stephen D. Camara, filed a lawsuit against Winco in Washoe County District Court alleging vicarious liability. Stephen D. Camara made a claim for loss of consortium.

Winco answered and denied allegations. Winco argued that Cindy Camara failed to use proper care and her injuries were proximately caused by her own negligence.

Although the jury found in favor of Cindy Camara, the jury found against Stephen Camara. Both the plaintiffs and the defendant filed motions of attorney fees and costs. The court awarded Winco \$3,000 for attorney's fees and \$1,801.25 for costs and gave credit for the jury's award to Cindy Camara. The net judgment was entered in the amount of \$3,203.35 in favor of Winco.
